

## NAIFA-Nebraska Distinguished Service Award

In 1996 the Nebraska State Association of Life Underwriters established the NSALU Distinguished Service Award, now called NAIFA-Nebraska Distinguished Service Award.

This award recognizes an individual member of NAIFA-Nebraska who during the course of their career has made outstanding contributions and given substantial and meritorious service to the institution of Life and Health Insurance.

### Nomination Procedure:

- Nominations for this award may be made by any member of NAIFA-Nebraska.
- A selection committee consisting of nine (9) association members from across the State will determine the recipient.
- When an individual is selected to receive this most prestigious award, it will be presented at the NAIFA-Nebraska Annual Business Meeting, Annual LILI Banquet, or some other statewide event as determined by the Board of Directors.
- It is possible that this award may be awarded posthumously.

### Selection Committee

2. State Secretary/Treasurer
3. State Immediate Past President
4. Four State Board Directors
5. Two past DSA recipients appointed by the NAIFA-Nebraska President
